SPECIAL AD HOC COMMITTEE OF STUDENTS  
FORMED AT "DAY OF CONSCIENCE" SESSIONS

APRIL 15, 1968

- I. We demand that the Administration have only suggestive power instead of veto power in the hiring and dismissing of faculty members.
- II. We demand that the SGA constitution and the two planks on student rights be approved by the administration and put in effect immediately.
- III. We demand that pending the acceptance and implementation of Point I all action of a terminating nature in regard to faculty be held in abeyance.
- IV. We demand that the SGA be made financially autonomous.
- V. We demand that the Student government be made open to all students.
- VI. We demand that a policy be adopted to point out to the conservative status quo the need for change regarding racial tension; in the residence situation, leadership advances, financial aid procedures, etc. and to bring about the cultural enlightenment of both groups concerning the Black Man in America.
- VII. We demand, that since a student must request deferral by the university concerning his draft status, it should be his responsibility to notify the draft board of any change in status, therefore the university will not release any information to the student's draft board unless the student so requests such a release.
